	<p>Play 4v4 in appropriately sized field. 3 progressions are, to score a point:  1<sup>st</sup> – can stop ball on <b>any</b> line for a point.  2<sup>nd</sup> – can stop ball on either <b>endline</b> for a point.  3<sup>rd</sup> – can stop a ball on only designated endline for point.</p>		<p>Play 4v4 to 4 small goals which can be placed either on the width, near the touchline on either endline <b>or</b> one goal on <b>each</b> line. Teams can score on either of 2 designated goals and must defend the remaining goals. Organizing &amp; problem solving is key!</p>
<p align="center"><b>4v4 to Target Players</b></p>	<p align="center">Explanation</p>	<p align="center"><b>4v4 to 2 Big Goals w/GKs</b></p>	<p align="center">Explanation</p>
	<p>Play 4v4 to target players. There are several different setups:  1-can have 2 or 4 target players.  2-can score just by completing a pass to <b>any</b> target player or <b>only</b> certain players.  3-must receive pass back from target in order to score a point.</p>		<p>Play 4v4 regular soccer with throw ins, corners, goalkicks, etc. to 2 big goals, each with a goalkeeper to defend it.</p> <p>Make this field a bit bigger than the others, but still properly proportioned.</p> <p>Can add a point for completing 5 passes.</p>
